- regional planning.

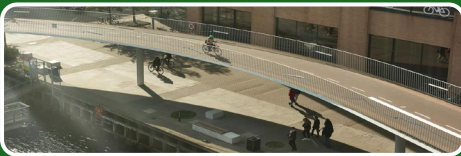
