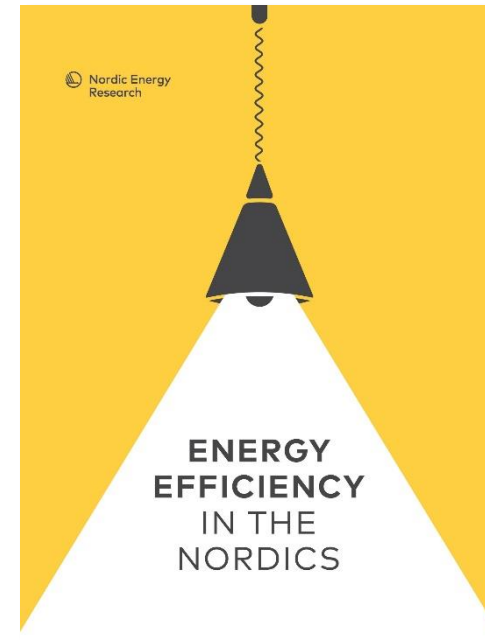
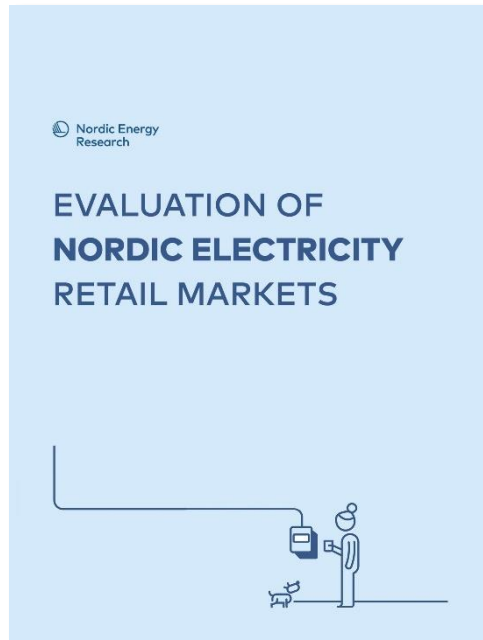
He urged Nordic countries to work together to amplify impact. He noted that individually, our nations are small, but by working together, the Nordics can lead in energy efficiency.

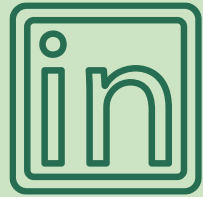
